Basilica of San Crisogono, Rome (Italy): Celebrating the Centenary of the Beatification of Anna Maria Taigi

Saturday, May 30, 2020, Pentecost Eve, the Centenary of the Beatification of Anna Maria Taigi was celebrated in the Basilica of San Crisogono in Rome (Italy). The Solemn Eucharistic Concelebration was presided over by the Minister General, Father Luigi Buccarello, and was attended by the Trinitarian religious of the communities of Rome, the Trinitarian religious of the various institutes present in Rome, the Trinitarian laity of the various cities of Italy and the faithful devoted to Taigi. Being a great figure both for the Church and for the entire Trinitarian family, the centenary of the Beatification of Anna Maria Taigi could not go unnoticed. Therefore, the celebrations of this centenary will take place for a year from 17/10/2020 with a solemn Eucharistic concelebration presided over by His Eminence Cardinal Angelo De Donatis, Vicar of the Pope and will close on May 30, 2021. Special functions, spiritual exercises, and pilgrimages will be held at the Basilica of San Crisogono where the body of our Blessed is kept. All are invited to join us in prayer during this Centenary of the Beatification of Anna Maria Taigi to thank God.





On May 25, 2020, at the General Curia in Rome, APPS students met with members of the General Council. During this moment of fraternal sharing, our candidates for solemn profession had the opportunity to get to know the members of the General

Government and to understand the work done by them and the importance of the Curia in the life of the Order. The meeting concluded with a guided tour of the new headquarters of the General Curia and the Basilica of San. Crisogono. It was an exciting and very enriching moment for everyone.







Thursday, June 4, 2020, the Shrine Madonna del Soccorso at Cori in Italy, hosted the Minister General Father Gino Buccarello and the members of the General Council, the communities of the Fathers of Cori and Palestrina, the President of the Trinitarian lay people of Cori and the various members, Dr. Nobili Fernando President of the Onlus Solidarity and Freedom.

At the conference held in the morning Father Luca Volpe, Minister of the community of Cori, also spoke about the importance of the figure of the priest as a gift of grace and mercy, from whose source the Christian can draw. Father Settimio, a Trinitarian exorcist from the diocese of Latina, also participated, who reiterated that the mission of the priest is to fight the slavery of the devil.

The day continued with the recitation of the Holy Trisagion, lunch, in the afternoon the exposition and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, the rosary and the Holy Mass celebrated by the Minister General.

### Rome (Italy): Feast of Blessed Anna Maria Taigi

Tuesday, June 9, 2020, the day on which the Church commemorates Blessed Anna Maria Taigi, many pilgrims from Rome and the surrounding area arrived at the Basilica of San Crisogono (Rome, Italy) to pay homage to her remains kept inside the Basilica. The Trinitarian family gathered once again to participate actively in the Solemn Eucharistic concelebration to honor and venerate the first lay Trinitarian beatified on the day of the Holy Trinity, May 30, 1920, by Pope Benedict XV.



This year's celebration, which marks the centenary of her beatification, was presided over by Mgr. Daniele Libanori, Auxiliary Bishop of Rome, and concelebrated by Father Luigi Buccarello, Minister General, the General Councillors, the Minister Provincial, Fr. Giovanni Martire Savina, of the Province of St. John de Matha (Italy), by Trinitarian priests, other priests, with the participation of Trinitarian religious and other Institutes of Religious, the President of the Trinitarian Laity of Italy and many lay Trinitarians of the various fraternities of Italy.

The Bishop in his enlightening homily highlighted on the holiness of life of our Blessed in the light of the readings that the Church proposed to us on that day. Stressing that Anna Maria Taigi in her simplicity, welcomed the Word of Jesus in her heart, lived it and put it into practice, opening her heart to the families in difficulty and to the poorest people of the city of Rome where she lived.

The day ended with a pleasant moment with an exchange of good wishes in the parish hall.



# Naples (Italy): Pontifical University of Southern Italy, Faculty of Theology of San Luigi section.



On June 17, 2020 our Brother and Minister General Fr. Buccarello Luigi discussed the dissertation for the Licentiate in **Fundamental** Theology the on theme: Religious freedom and interreligious dialogue: an open challenge.

In addition to his research work, Fr. Luigi opened new horizons to the charism hoping for an effective spread of freedom as an antidote to the current persecutions in today's world. Despite the health emergency due to covid19, which forced everyone to respect the precautionary norms issued by the Italian government, the discussion took place regularly a special note of thanks to the efficient preparation carried out by the Faculty.



The discussion was open to the public with a limited number of people. The General Councillors, the Provincial Minister, of the Province of St. John de Matha (Italy-Mexico-Poland-Vietnam) and his Council, other priests, the Trinitarian Family, relatives, and acquaintances were present for the discussion. At the end of the discussion, the Commission congratulated the Minister General and the Order for the depth and completeness of its work and communicated its approval.





In the name of the authority of the Holy See and the Statutes of the Faculty, the President of the Commission proclaimed that Fr. Luigi, has obtained a licentiate in Sacred Theology with the qualification maxima cum laude probatus.

## INDIA: A TRINITARY SOCIAL RESPONSE OF THE VICE PROVINCE Saint Michael of the Saints



Engaging in difficult times has always been a characteristic of the Trinitarians. And we could not help ourselves even in this Covid-19 emergency time. A time when mankind faces this invisible and fearsome enemy. There are many people whose lives may not matter to the majority. These are the low-income families and migrant families. The Trinitarians in India are making great efforts to do the best they can, reaching out to the needy and the afflicted.

The communities of the Vice Province of St. Michael of the Saints (India) carry out special prayers on behalf of our brothers and sisters in precarious situations. The communities of Assam and Bangalore provide essential food for the neediest in nearby villages.

In Assam about 80 families have been counted and in Bangalore 25 families. In addition, in collaboration with the Jesuits of Karnataka, the Trinitarian community in Bangalore has made about 2000 bags of food grains each



containing 25-30 kilograms of food items. The Assam community reached several villages to educate and raise awareness about how to remain safe during the pandemic.

#### **IN MEMORIAM**

### Father Salvador Egido Vicente

On Saturday, May 23, 2020, Fr. Salvador Egido Vicente, of the Community of the Virgin Shrine of Cabeza-Andújar left for his Father's house.

Fr. Salvador was born in Masueco de la Ribera (Salamanca), on 06-08-1939. He entered the Novitiate of Antequera (Malaga) on 12-10-1957 and made his Simple Profession on 13-10-1958 in Antequera (Malaga) and his Solemn Profession on 23-09-1962 in Cordoba. He was ordained a priest on 04-06-1966 in Madrid.

He was assigned to Cordoba from 1962 to 1966, then to the missions in Madagascar where he carried out his pastoral missionary life for 6 years. After his missionary experience, in Cordoba and Valdepeñas he carried out his pastoral and teaching work until 1975. His missionary spirit brought him back to our homes in the Vicariate of America. Fr. Salvador held the positions of parish priest in Hernando and Buenos Aires and in Spain he was parish vicar in the shrine of Our Lady of Cabeza. As a teacher he dedicated part of his life in our schools in Valdepeñas (1974-1975), Aluche (Madrid) from 1993-1996 Andújar (Jaén) from 1996 to 2005.

We feel in communion of prayer with our brothers in the Province of the Holy Spirit, and we join in thanking for the life of our brother. May the Holy Trinity receive him in her womb of infinite love.

### Father Domingo Reyes Fernandez

Fr. Domingo Reyes Fernandez of the Province of the Holy Spirit left for the house of the Father on May 24, 2020. He was born on January 29, 1950 in Carriches (Toledo). With the support and love of his parents he responded to the call of the Lord, beginning his religious life at the Trinitarian School of Alcazar de San Juan. After completing his studies, he entered the Order's novitiate in Antequera on 8 September 1966 and made his first profession on 1 September 1968. He made his solemn profession in the Church of San Carlino in Rome on April 28, 1973. He was ordained priest on 21 July 1974 in Cordoba. After his ordination he was the Director of the minor seminary of the Order in Antequera.

For many years he was a missionary in Madagascar and Professor of Sacred Scripture. He then returned to Algeciras in Spain, then to Antequera as minister, pastor, and chaplain. He left us after fighting two years against an incurable disease. May he now rest in peace and may the Holy Trinity receive him in her womb of infinite love.

#### Father Jean Felix Richard Ranaivomanana

Fr. Jean Felix Richard Ranaivomanana of the Province of Our Lady of Good Remedy left us on June 13, 2020.

He was born in Ambohibary on January 29, 1968. He entered the novitiate in Moramanga on October 7, 1992 and made Simple Profession on October 8, 1993 in Moramanga and Solemn Profession on October 8, 2000 in Moramanga. He was ordained a priest on 03-08-2002 in Antananarivo. Immediately afterwards he was appointed vicar of the district of the northern region of the diocese of Tsiroanomandidy until 24 June 2007. Afterwards he was responsible for the formation of the student brothers of Antsirabe and prison chaplain shortly afterwards. On November 16, 2008, the Province suggested him as National Chaplain of the FTMTK (Association of Young Catholic Farmers in Madagascar), and a year later he was appointed Minister of the House of the Most Holy Trinity in Antelohasina Antsirabe. He remained in Antsirabe until September 17, 2018, when the Province accepted his request to retire from his responsibilities and settle in Ambohidahy Tsiroanomandidy because of his health which did not allow him to carry out his mission as chaplain. In 2020 he went up to the provincial curia to follow his health closely. Despite all the care, on Saturday, June 13, 2020, he returned his soul to God. Let us pray for him that he may rest in peace. May God welcome him into His Paradise. R.I.P.
